# Why do we need your help?

Each year thousands of animals are sent to shelters and euthanized because of the high costs of care, many with treatable medical conditions. Legally, companion animals are viewed as property but we at Tommy's Holiday Fund see these animals instead as family members who do not qualify for human medical insurance. Pet insurance is available, but these programs do not always cover the total cost of necessary medical care, or are beyond the current means of families in financial crisis. There are also credit accounts specifically for pet care, but many families cannot qualify for these programs. Free spay and neuter clinics as well as vaccination clinics are common, but typically only free or low cost veterinary services are available. The goal of Tommy's Holiday Fund is to make animal medical care available to all who need it.


### Difficult decisions...

Emergency and specialty animal care services can range from \$200.00 to \$15,000.00 depending on the procedure needed. Long term care of a diabetic or other specialty needs animal can be very costly as medicines alone can be hundreds of dollars per prescription. Financial hardships can happen to anyone and usually come with life changing surprises, like losing a job, accident, disability, or healthcare costs of other family members. These families should not have to give up their cherished companions to shelters or, even worse, euthanasia.



# In the Community...

Tommy's Holiday Fund supports our community in many ways. Our assistance helps prevent further suffering of companion animals and their families. Keeping the animals at home with their families reduces the number of animals who are sent to shelters each year, lowering the fiscal and overpopulation issues, with which these shelters and local communities face.



Tommy's Holiday Fund helps families provide prompt attention to their pet's healthcare concerns, lessening the spread of illness and disease. Above all, THF will provide information to animal caretakers regarding preventative care, medical resources, and financial options, ensuring these families are able to establish their own resources and avoid future medical and financial crises through proper planning and care.

In an effort to provide optimal care for both families and pets, we will work with the family's primary vet, or one of our partnering clinics to offset or cover care costs for the pet. The level of assistance is commensurate upon availability. Additional assistance for families dealing with, or escaping, domestic violence will be offered help in the form of food, and supplies, and financial assistance for veterinary care and required medication.
